IN THE AREA (in no particular order)

Poughkeepsie Train Station to The Big Apple: visit NYC

The Trevor Zoo located at Millbrook School, 131 Millbrook School Road, Millbrook, NY 12545, Phone: 845-677-3704, a six acre facility housing more than 180 animals including 7 endangered species, Hours 8:30AM-5PM every day of the year, Adults \$5, Children \$3, www.trevorzoo.org

Mid-Hudson Children's Museum located at 75 North Water Street, Poughkeepsie, NY 12601; Hours Fridays 9:30AM-5PM and Sundays 11AM-5PM; Admission \$6.50 (coupon for \$1 OFF on website www.mhcm.org)

Old Rhinebeck Aerodrome located at 9 Norton Road, Rhinebeck, NY 12572; Phone: 845-752-3200. While the airshow season does not start until June 12th, the museum is open on Sunday June 6, 2010 from 10-5PM and possible practice flights can be viewed; aviation history is preserved at the Aerodrome; Museum admission Adults \$10, Teens \$8, Children \$3; www.OldRhinebeck.org

Krazy City located at the Poughkeepsie Galleria Mall on Route 9 South, across the hall from Regal Theater if you want to catch a movie before or after – Krazy City includes arcade, Roller Ball, Skyscraper ride, mini-golf, ball maze, rock climb, bumper cars and more. www.KrazyCity.com

Fun Central located at 1630 Route 9 Wappingers Falls, NY 12590; Phone (845) 297-1010; attractions include arcade games, 18-hole mini golf course, a virtual ride coaster, Batting Cages, Mining and snack-bar; www.fun-central.com

Rail Trails (walk, bike or rollerblade): Dutchess County Rail Trail (2.4 miles Morgan Lake to Overrocker Road in Town of Poughkeepsie, once completed this park will be 12 linear miles), Harlem Valley Rail Trail (10 miles through towns of Millerton, North East, Amenia and Wassaic), and Hudson Valley Rail Trail in Ulster County (2.37 miles from Mid-Hudson Bridge in Highland, NY to Route 299/Town of Lloyd)

Walkway Over the Hudson – A NYS park providing access to view the Hudson River's breathtaking landscape for pedestrians, hikers, joggers, bicyclists, and people with disabilities; the bridge deck stands 212 feet above the river's surface and is 6,678 feet (1.28 miles) long, making it the longest, elevated pedestrian bridge in the world. Parking Locations and Entranceways can be found in two locations: 1) At 87 Haviland Road, Highland, NY (Ulster County), parking is allowed along the north side of the road, with ADA-compliant handicapped parking spaces at the entrance to the bridge. 2) At 61

Parker Avenue, Poughkeepsie (Dutchess County) there is an 80 car parking lot, with ADA-compliant handicapped parking provided. Additional parking may be found, where permitted, along city streets nearby.

SplashDown Beach Water Park located at 16 Old Route 9 West, Fishkill, NY 12524; Tickets range \$24.50-29.50 with half-day rates available; water rides and swimming, reptile exhibit; www.splashdownbeach.com

National Historic Sites include FDR Home and Library, Vall-Kill (cottage of Eleanor Roosevelt), Vanderbilt Mansion, Hyde Park Railroad Station 1914, Mills mansion/Staatsburgh State Historic Site, Locust Grove/Samuel Morse Historic Site

Vassar College located at 124 Raymond Avenue, Poughkeepsie; the campus has beautiful architecture and gardens, Vassar Farm, galleries, libraries and museum, many of which are open to the public, www.vassar.edu

In nearby Ulster County:

Minnewaska State Park is situated in Ulster County on the dramatic Shawangunk Mountain ridge that rises more than 2,000 feet above sea level. The terrain is rugged and rocky, blanketed by dense hardwood forest encircling two lakes. Clear streams cut into valleys, incising sheer cliffs and ledges and emerging in waterfalls. Hiking, biking, horseback riding and cross-country skiing are very popular activities. Visitors also enjoy swimming, picnicking, boating and marveling at the scenery. Lake Minnewaska is located on route 44/55 in Ulster County, New York. Upon exiting the New York State Thruway in New Paltz (Exit 18) (north or south), make a LEFT on Route 299. Stay on 299 for approximately 6 miles. At Junction Route 44/55 make a Right. Park entrance is about 6 miles up winding mountain road on Left.

Mohonk Preserve, Visitor Center located ½ mile west of the intersection of Route 44/55 and Route 299, Gardiner, NY (6 miles west of New Paltz); Phone (845) 255-0919; you have to see it to believe it, Visitor's Center is free and includes Kids Discovery Corner, indoor exhibits about the preserve and a ¼ mile trail and garden; explore the Preserve's 70 miles of trails and carriage roads: bikers and hikers \$10, kids free;
